

Hey Trunk-ers!

We are SO excited to have you joining our Trunk-Or-Treat event as a Trunk-er! We are thrilled to be reaching out to families from all over the Warner Robins area for this year's event. This is an easy and fun way to show our community that we see and love them! As a Trunk-er, you are a HUGE part of what makes this event such a hit! We want you AND our families to have to BEST experience while we are together, so here are some things to know about our night:

- Staff will be on-site starting at 5:00pm. Please have your Trunk station up and ready to receive families by 5:45pm - you never know who might be stopping by early!
- We will be spacing each trunk out so we are both social distancing between kids AND trunks, so taking direction from our parking lot team of students and young adults will be very important.
- Masks will be encouraged, but not required for this event. We do have both kid and adult FirstKidz masks available should you need one for the night.
- We will encourage families to start on one end of the parking lot and move around to each trunk in the same direction to avoid potential for cross-traffic contact.
- Prepare for 2-4 pieces of candy per kid with about 100 kids coming through. All candy should be prepackaged (aka no homemade goods or candy not individually wrapped). We suggest providing candy that is allergy-free, but it's *your* Trunk, so go crazy! We will have backup candy should you run out, but don't rely solely on our stash.
- Plan to set your bowl/bag/cauldron of candy out 6 feet away from your trunk to allow for "contact-less candy distribution". Kids will be asked to take a candy from each trunk/spot and proceed to the next trunk.
- "Power accessible spots" will be first-reserve, first serve. If you requested power, I will confirm availability with you before the event. Please bring your own extension cords and power strips - each vehicle will only be guaranteed one outlet.
- We will be giving out prizes for the BEST TRUNKS (Fan Favorite, Spookiest, and Holiest) so I expect ALL-OUT PARTICIPATION!! You can't go TOO BIG or TOO SMALL with your Trunk! As long as you are crazy about your Trunk, families who join us will be crazy about it too. - Kids will receive a Trunk-Or-Treat bag upon arrival with information about all the amazing things we do here at FUMC! If families have questions about our programs, we encourage you to share about all the fun we have or direct them to a staff member.

Your goal is to decorate/build/create a unique and amazing Trunk for the kids of Warner Robins to Trick-Or-Treat at- just like you would at home for kids in your neighborhood.
